tin cans are in the red box.

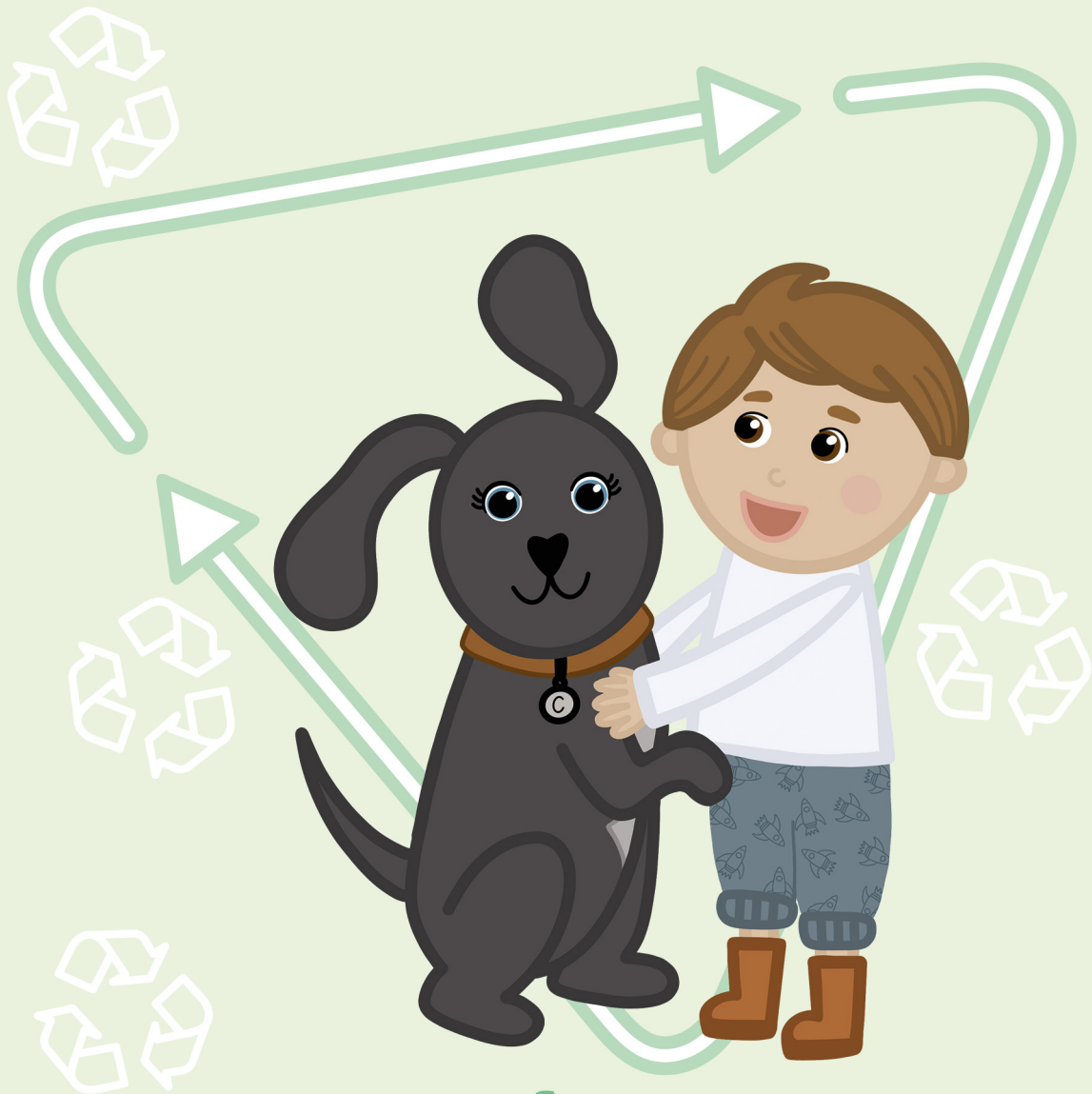
One, two

3. These are two recycling symbols...



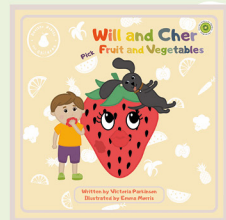
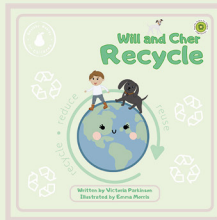
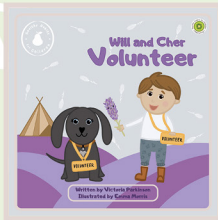
